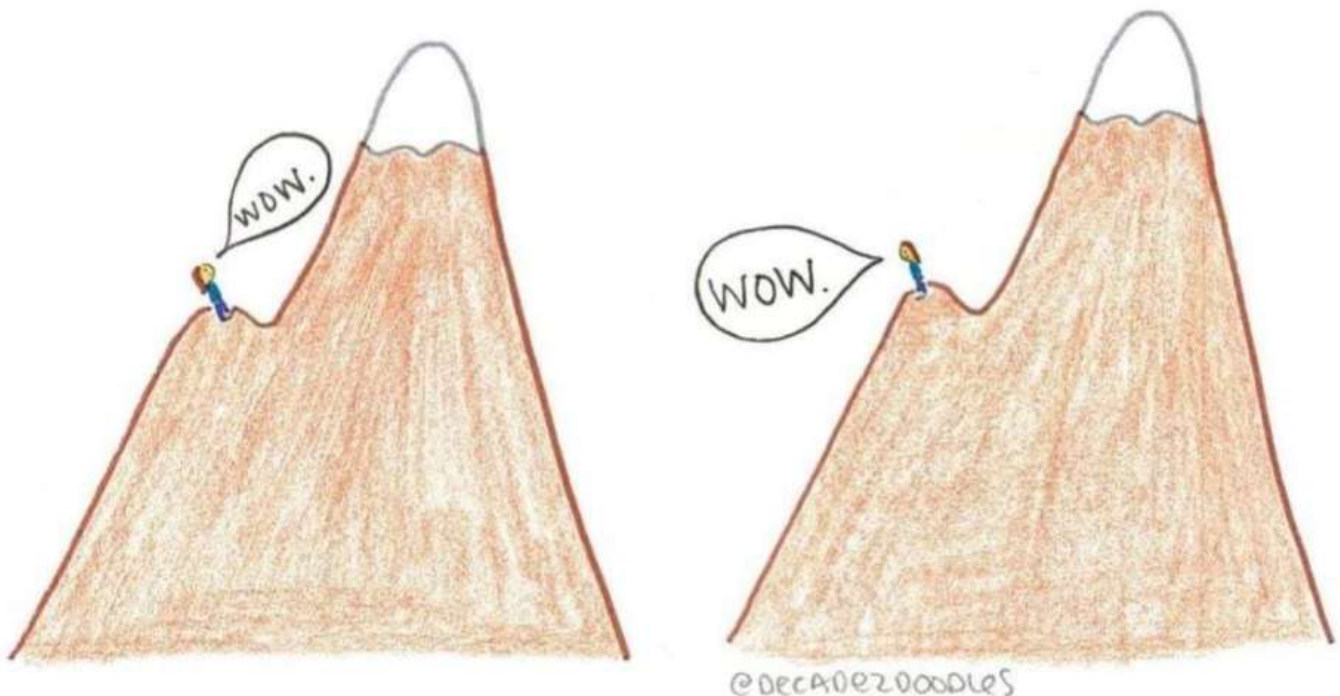
## A Message from Director Kevin Savage

## Peer Supports

The Division is starting a new service called Peer Supports. **Peer Support** means people with I/DD mentor or coach other people with I/DD. A peer can help someone with empowerment, advocacy, and social inclusion.

**Empowerment** means to become stronger and more confident in controlling your own life.

**Advocacy** means helping someone express what they want and need.

**Social Inclusion** means to feel valued by society. It means people with I/DD have the chance to take part in the same things that people without I/DD do.

This service will start with a pilot. A **pilot** is a small test of something new to see how it works. In September, two providers will begin billing for the Peer Support Services they provide.

A workgroup has been meeting since this past Spring to talk about Peer Supports. They decided what the service needs to do. This is written in what is called Certification Standards. They also decided what skills workers need to do peer support. This is called the Core Competencies of Peer Support. The group also decided how to roll out peer support services. This includes how to bill for the service and how to find workers to be peer supporters.

This work just starting! Look for future updates as Peer Supports grow.

## RIDDC Receives the Champions in Action Award

Congratulation to the Rhode Island Developmental Disabilities Council (RIDDC) for receiving the “Champions in Action” Award from Citizens Bank in partnership with Channel 10!

Kevin Nerney, Executive Director, RIDDC and Sue Babin, Statewide Director of the RI Small Business Self Employment Incubator, accepted a \$50,000 check from Citizens Bank, surrounded by leaders within the state’s developmental disabilities community, RI Department of Labor & Training (DLT), and RI Dept of Behavioral Healthcare, Developmental Disabilities & Hospitals (BHDDH), as well as staff, small business owners/project participants and their families and support staff.



The award category was “Building Employment Pathways for Individuals with Diverse Abilities.”

Citizens will provide \$50,000 in funding, media and promotional support, and volunteer assistance to RIDDC dedicated to building employment pathways for individuals with diverse abilities. RIDDC will use the funding to support the transformative Self-Employment Business Incubator.
